

The Fundación José Ortega y Gasset (FJOG) is a private, non-profit institution devoted to cultural activities, debate and research for the dissemination of Knowledge in Social Sciences and Humanities. Inspired by the figure of its founder and the important role he played in the Spanish society of his time, the Fundación was created in 1978 by Soledad Ortega Spottorno.

The Fundación has a number of centers and departments which carry out many different activities. These activities are, among others, graduate education, undergraduate courses for american programs, applied research, seminars and conferences, lectures, round tables, publications, courses for teachers of Spanish as a second language, exhibitions and technical assistance to public and private corporations and multilateral organizations.

The development of these activities has bound the Fundación to a group of academics and prestigious professionals which form one of the think tanks or more reputable groups of experts in Spain, with their support, this institution has become an important meeting-point and private debate, which usually host outstanding business, political, economical, academic and management representatives from all over the world.

The Fundación has its headquarters in Madrid and an international center in the city of Toledo. In its process of international expansion led us to expand and be present in Argentina (Buenos Aires), Colombia (Bogota) and México, as well as the regular organization of activities in other countries in Latinamerica, specially the Dominican Republic, Chile, Brazil, Uruguay and Peru, where a center of the Instituto Universitario de Investigación Ortega y Gasset was inaugurated in year 2005.

The Fundación, in order to reach its aims, has established in the course of its lifetime, agreements with hundreds of corporations, companies, Spanish and foreign institutions, and very outstanding academic and research centers such as St. Antony's College, Oxford, Institut d'Études Politiques de Paris (Sciences Po), Colegio de Mexico, Cornell University, Instituto Torcuato di Tella, Southern Methodist University, among others.

The Fundación, together with these agreements, and with the purpose of increasing scientific exchanges, has consolidated a very wide network of relations inside and outside Spain which made it one of the most dynamic institutions of the country.

El Instituto Universitario de Investigación Ortega y Gasset (IUIOG) is a center for postgraduate education and research in Social Sciences and Humanities, essentially equivalent to the graduate schools of American Universities. Created in 1986 at the Fundación José Ortega y Gasset now Fundación Ortega Marañón, was the first institute promoted and managed by a private entity, attached to a public university.

Today its board is composed of institutional representatives of the Foundation, the Autonomous Community of Madrid, the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport and the Universidad Complutense de Madrid, which joins a select group of scholars chosen by consensus.

The Institute has an international vocation, only 53 percent of its students are Spaniards, while the rest is divided among a total of 33 nationalities. The institute's educational model meets the objective of providing high quality education. The faculty consists of professors and senior lecturers of some 60 universities and higher institutions of research, of which about half are Spanish and the rest divided equally between Europe, U.S. and Latin America. Along with these academic teachers a large group of renowned professionals, including predominantly businessmen, officials and lawyers.

The Instituto Universitario Ortega y Gasset is located in the heart of Madrid, between the streets of Miguel Ángel and General Martínez Campos, close to the US embassy, and has
