

LEX SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION: February 28, 2013

Schools which have been granted a LEX chapter by January 1, 2013 are eligible to have their academically qualified students (B average or above) apply for these financial awards.

AAfPE will award up to five \$500 scholarships, for the pursuit of the student's paralegal education. Award checks will be made payable jointly to the awardee and the awardee's school. A national committee representative of the five AAfPE membership regions will make the final selection of the recipients.

All applications should be forwarded to AAfPE Headquarters, so that they may be assigned to the committee for evaluation. Please submit all applications in time to **arrive** at AAfPE by **February 28, 2013**, at the following address:

All applications must be received by mail with original signatures on the certification/permission to print form. The application package will include the following materials:

- 1. An essay of 500 to 750 words (two to three doubled spaced typed pages) on the topic selected by the LEX Scholarship Committee. Essays should be written with standard margins and type size; applicants should be aware going over the maximum page and word limits may result in point deductions.
- 2. Completed LEX Scholarship application.
- 3. Signed LEX Scholarship Certification and Permission to Print form.
- 4. An official transcript which will demonstrate at least a B average.
- 5. A letter indicating the applicant is a student in good standing from a faculty member.
