Ireland/UK: 2017

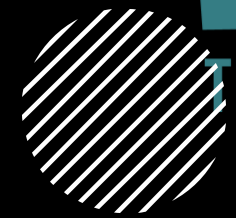
The Pacific Northwest/Vancouver: 2018

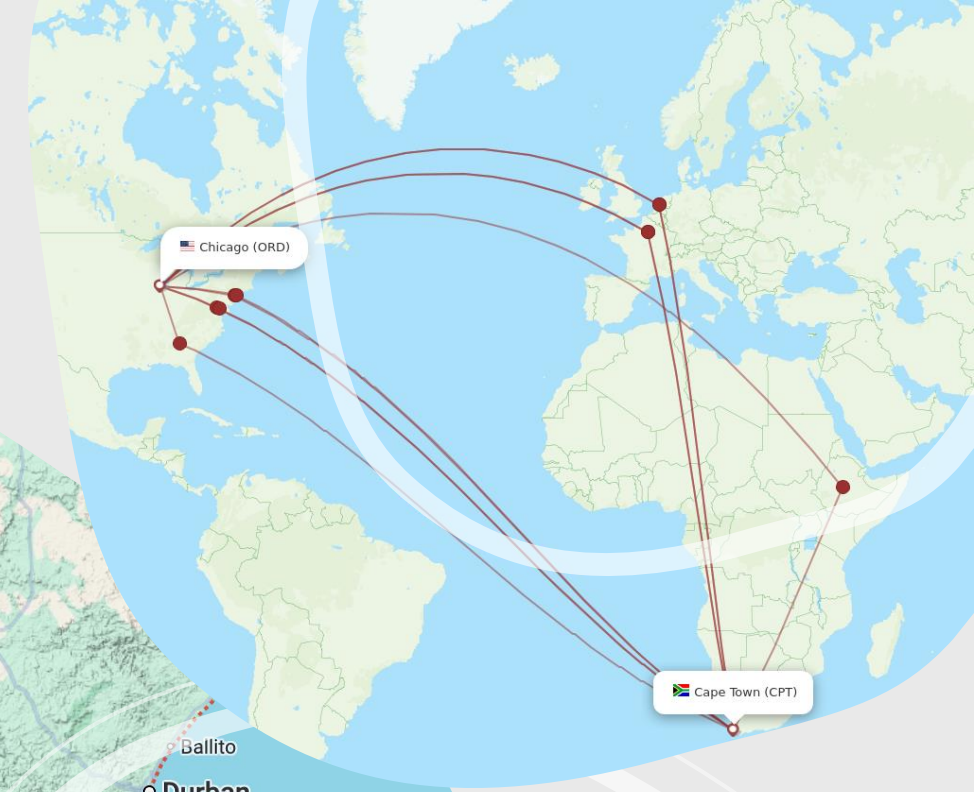

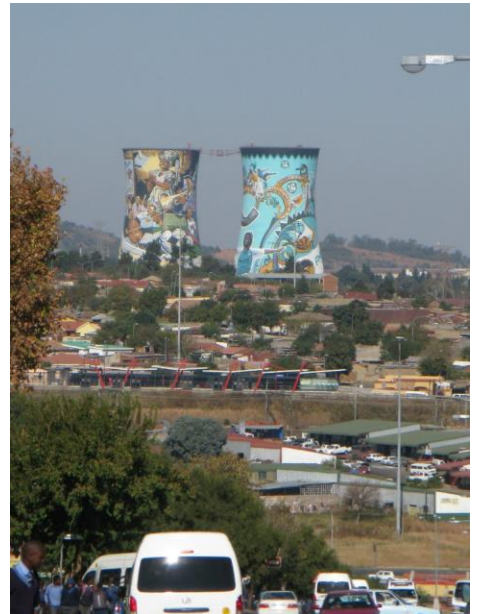
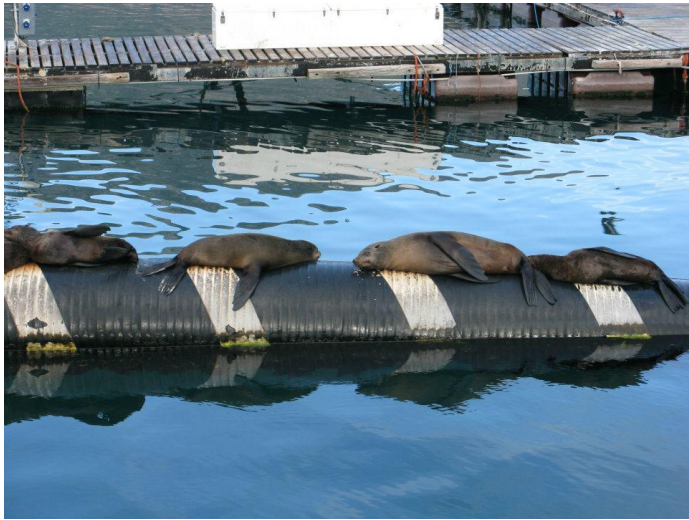
