Educational Philosophy

I strongly believe that the education of young musicians is an essential element in ensuring the survival of the musical art form, and it should be approached with the utmost thoughtfulness and care. My primary educational objective is to assist each student in building a strong foundation of control over their instrument. Through mastering the elements of tone production, vibrato, technique, and attention to detail in phrasing, the student becomes free to express themselves musically and perform with effortlessness and enjoyment. As I build strong relationships with my students, my goal is to assist them in discovering their greatest musical potential while tailoring the curriculum to fit their individual needs and taste. Each lesson is filled with positive energy and is focused on boosting the self-confidence of the students and encouraging them to perform as their best self.

Musical instruction should always be personalized to accommodate the individual learning style of each student regardless of their level. It is very important to maintain healthy and balanced instruction that blends the study of fundamentals with large-scale flute repertoire. I find that many high school students who go on to study flute at the collegiate level become so immersed in learning the staples of the flute repertoire that they forget to focus specifically on the fundamental techniques that are the foundation for musical works. My lessons are made up of the following:

- Scales and Arpeggios
- Tone Exercise
- Vibrato Exercise
- Tone/Vibrato Repertoire
- Finger Technique
- Etudes
- Orchestral Excerpts
- Solo Flute Repertoire

It is my primary goal to inspire and encourage young flutists to always focus on creating a beautiful sound with a variety of different tone colors that pay homage to the diversity of each musical genre. In order to achieve success, I focus on an in-depth study of De la Sonorite by Marcel Moyse and A Consequence of Sequences by Paul Edmund Davies. I believe that each student should always be studying a beautiful melody from Tone Development Through Interpretation by Marcel Moyse or additional supplemental material that incorporates a combination of tone production and vibrato study. I teach all major and minor scales and arpeggios full compass in all styles and articulation patterns in order to ensure the technical proficiency of each student. These elements are taught through demonstration, and each student must perform them from memory.

I assign a focused, goal-based practice routine for each student based on their day-to-day schedule and individual needs. This routine not only includes the fundamentals of tone production, vibrato, finger technique, etudes, and repertoire, but also incorporates reading and listening. Each student keeps a journal for their lessons in which I write their assignments, as well as key points from each lesson that they should incorporate into their individual practice routine. I also encourage them to write in their journals during their practice time in order to keep track of the ideas that are working for them and those that need to be revisited or revised.

Every student performs a solo and collaborates in a group performance for my bi-annual studio recitals in order to gain comfort and confidence in the performance setting. This experience allows them the opportunity to collaborate with their colleagues and develop their skills in the areas of stage presence and public speaking. To assist my students for success in performance, I hold recital and audition preparation classes during which the students produce mock performances for an audience of their peers. During these classes, we not only discuss successful elements of a performance, but we also focus on "training" for the musical event and the importance of effective sleep patterns, nutrition, and stress reduction.

I strongly believe in my ability to instruct, advise, and mentor flutists of all ages, allowing them to expand their own vision of what is possible in their lives. As a flute instructor, I believe that all students have an equal opportunity for success when they are placed in a stimulating learning environment with high expectations and a nurturing educator. Effective learning requires a collaboration between the teacher and the student and should be grounded on mutual respect and trust. Lastly, I believe that each student should discover true freedom in musical expression surrounded by a supportive educational environment.
